Spanish: (Valera 1602 Purified)

*...la leche no adulterada de la palabra,
para que por ella crezcáis:*

Portuguese: (TBS 1994)

*...o leite racional, nao falsificado,
para que por ele vades crescendo;*

Polluted Seed

English: (RSV)

*...long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it
you may grow up to salvation;*

Spanish: (RV 1960)

*...la leche espiritual no adulterada,
para que por ella crezcáis para salvación.*

Portuguese: (Atualizada)

*...o genuíno leite espiritual, para que por ele
vos seja dado crescimento para salvação.*

Notice that the polluted seed adds the words “to salvation”. The Precious Seed teaches instantaneous salvation by grace not a works or process salvation. Missionaries should have Precious Seed. If they use polluted seed, they are using a bible that teaches that you “grow unto salvation”. Also, every time they buy a UBS copyrighted bible, they are supporting the UBS which are attempting to replace precious TR Bibles with polluted CT bibles all over the world.

Some make excuses and say there are only a few slight changes but I Corinthians 5:6 says, “*Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump?*” Rat poison is 99% nutritious and only 1% poison but it still kills the rats! Modernist bibles may be 99% good but they contain corruption that weakens a Christian. Another excuse is that the new modernist bibles are easier to understand. But what is more important, understanding man's words, or having God's Words?

What Bible do we distribute?

Occasionally we are asked which version of Scriptures we distribute in a given language. This brochure gives a short summary of our position on the Scriptures.

Just as there are modernist per-versions in English (anything other than the KJB), so it is in many other languages. God warns us of this danger in His own Word. Deuteronomy 4:2 says, “*Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.*” Proverbs 30:5-6 says, “*Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. Add thou not unto his words, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar.*” Also, Revelation 22:18 says, “*For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book.*” So we see God takes the purity of His Words seriously and has prophesied the attack against the Bible.

Of course, Satan has been behind this attack on the Words of God since the beginning. In Genesis 3 we see where Satan distorted the Word of God and caused doubt in the mind of Eve bringing sin and death. Satan continues his attack on the Bible even now. Through the centuries he has used heretical men to

corrupt manuscripts and translations of the Bible.

But God has promised to preserve His words (Matthew 5:18, 24:35) which He inspired. (II Timothy 3:16, II Peter 1:21) He has done it through faithful copies of the Hebrew Masoretic and Greek *Textus Receptus* (Received Text) and our beloved English King James Bible.

However, because of man’s manipulations and corrupt copies (called the “Critical Text”) some Bibles need purification. The devil has infiltrated the United Bible Societies (UBS) with modernist men which use the Critical Text instead of the Received Text. Unfortunately the UBS and other modernist publishers basically monopolize the so called bible industry. In most "Christian bookstores" you will find all kinds of versions to choose from. This short study will demonstrate some examples showing the difference between “precious” and “polluted” seed. “*And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.*” (Ezekiel 44:23)

It is sad to say but one must be careful even when it comes to choosing a Bible today. One can not judge a book by its cover. Just because it says “Holy Bible” on the cover does not make it holy. If you put a Chevrolet emblem on a Ford, does the Ford become a Chevy? Of course not!

The problem is that there are many options when one looks for a Bible. In II Corinthians 2:17 the Bible says, “*For we are not as many, which corrupt the word of God: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.*” Here we see that the devil has subtly corrupted many Bibles. For the sake of space we will just illustrate one omission and one addition in 3 languages (spoken by the author):

Omitting Jesus Christ in Ephesians 3:9

*...in God, who created all things
by Jesus Christ:*

Spanish: (Valera 1602 Purified)

*...Dios, que creó todas las cosas
por Jesu Cristo.*

Portuguese: (TBS 1994)

*...Deus, que tudo criou
por meio de Jesus Cristo;*

Polluted Seed

English: (RSV)

...in God who created all things;

Spanish: (RV 1960)

...en Dios, que creó todas las cosas;

Portuguese: (Corrigida)

...em Deus, que tudo criou

Precious Seed teaches that Jesus Christ is our Creator. Polluted seed omits Jesus Christ altogether, attacking the deity of Christ.
